These aim to enable individuals, communities, and groups to share and reuse methods for bottom-up change. In doing so, the project will build a mobile, nimble and curious resource that will make archived knowledge accessible and usable to a wide range of people.

online and open-access archive, assisted by Al. It will allow individual users and community groups to search for and activist alternatives to assist their ideas and projects.

What it useful art?

This project is connected to the idea of Arte Útil. Arte Útil is Spanish and can be translated literally as "useful art," but it also refers to the concept of "art as a tool." This concept is linked to the idea that art should question established systems and point out new possibilities for societal action. Arte Útil utilizes artistic thinking to create, develop, and implement tactics which enable us to reimagine and reshape the way we act in society. Based on an initiative of Cuban artist Tania Bruguera, the Asociación de Arte Útil was founded in 2013 - is a continuously growing network of committed individuals and cultural institutions promoting the development of Arte Útil around the world. ZKM | Karlsruhe with its director Alistair Hudson is a partner of the Arte Útil idea and archive, aiming to further research how art can be a tool of societal change.

Professor Anthony Stafford Beer was born on 25 Sep-How do Al tools support societal change? And what tember 1926 in London. He was a theorist and professor of the Manchester Business School, and founder of Management Cybernetics for which he is best known. Beer was employed by governments in over 20 countries and by a number of international agencies, held numerous academic posts and managerial positions and authored over 200 publications by the time of his death on 23 August 2002. He was also a published poet and exhibited painter. Projects he is particularly well known for include the proto-internet Project Cybersyn Ultimately, this will lead to the development of a shared in Chile, and Team Syntegrity. He was appointed Honorary Professor of Organisational Transformation at Liverpool Polytechnic, now Liverpool John Moores Universiarchival information, generating a 'Playbook' of Useful Art ty, in 1989. The Stafford Beer Collection is held at LJMU Special Collections & Archives.

Key steps of the project:

- a) Cataloguing, digitising and archiving the LJMU Stafford Beer archive as a source code for online archiving as activist exchange.
- b) Utilising the knowledge and skills base of ZKM | Karlsruhe to develop online and offline AI tools. These will enable the accessibility of a growing archive of information to users as bespoke toolkits and playbooks for change.
- c) Enabling the growing network artistic reseach, in collaboration with the Association of Arte Útil, to develop a growing and open-source repository of research, knowledge-production and activist strategies for community change.
- d) Enabling the development and research of Latin American based digital and cybernetic initiatives as a basis for a growing international research dialogue around decolonialisation and the Decentralisation of Political Economies.
